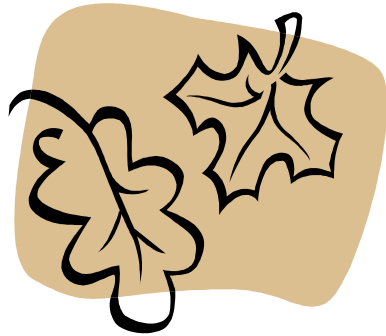

~ SCRIPTURE LESSON ~ LUKE 16:1-13

16:1 He also said to the disciples, "There was a rich man who had a steward, and charges were brought to him that this man was wasting his goods. 2 And he called him and said to him, 'What is this that I hear about you? Turn in the account of your stewardship, for you can no longer be steward.' 3 And the steward said to himself, 'What shall I do, since my master is taking the stewardship away from me? I am not strong enough to dig, and I am ashamed to beg. 4 I have decided what to do, so that people may receive me into their houses when I am put out of the stewardship.' 5 So, summoning his master's debtors one by one, he said to the first, 'How much do you owe my master?' 6 He said, 'A hundred measures of oil.' And he said to him, 'Take your bill, and sit down quickly and write fifty.' 7 Then he said to another, 'And how much do you owe?' He said, 'A hundred measures of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, and write eighty.' 8 The master commended the dishonest steward for his shrewdness; for the sons of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than the sons of light. 9 And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of unrighteous mammon, so that when it fails they may receive you into the eternal habitations.

Cavar, no puedo; mendigar, me da verg:uenza. 4 Ya sé lo que haré para que cuando se me quite de la mayordomía, me reciban en sus casas. 5 Y llamando a cada uno de los deudores de su amo, dijo al primero: ¿Cuánto debes a mi amo? 6 Él dijo: Cien barriles de aceite. Y le dijo: Toma tu cuenta, siéntate pronto, y escribe cincuenta. 7 Después dijo a otro: Y tú, ¿cuánto debes? Y él dijo: Cien medidas de trigo. Él le dijo: Toma tu cuenta, y escribe ochenta. 8 Y alabó el amo al mayordomo malo por haber hecho sagazmente; porque los hijos de este siglo son más sagaces en el trato con sus semejantes que los hijos de luz. 9 Y yo os digo: Ganad amigos por medio de las riquezas injustas, para que cuando éstas faltan, os reciban en las moradas eternas.
