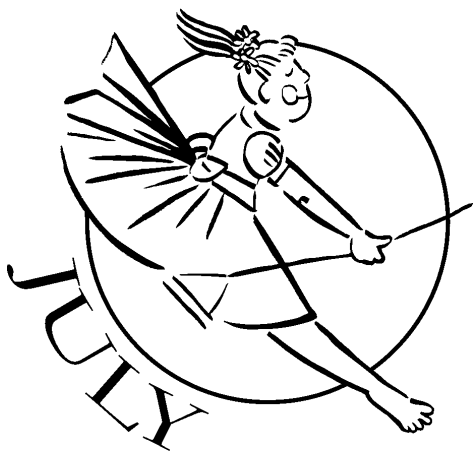
DAILY TEXTS ORDERS

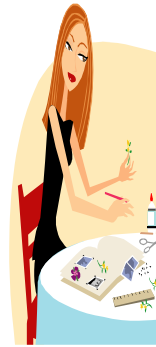

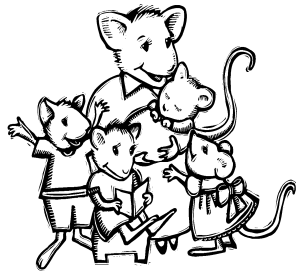

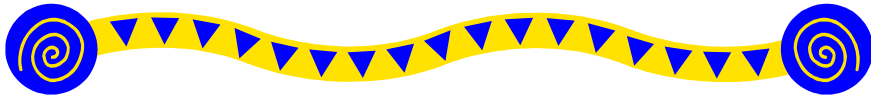
Our Junior High members will be attending Laurel Ridge during the week of Sunday July 8th through Saturday July 14th.

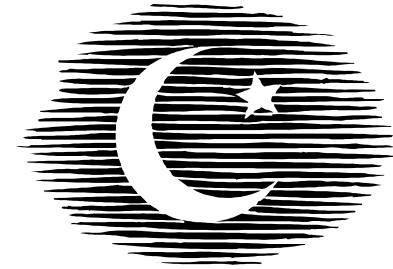
