ESL Classes Starting Back

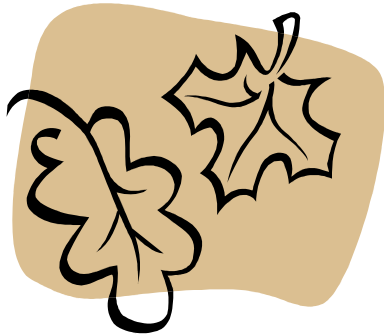

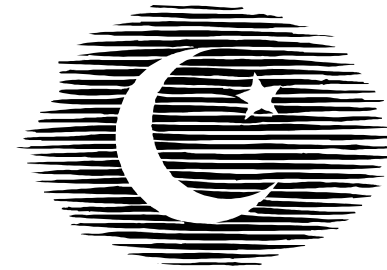

We will be getting more information to you as the time comes, for this is still in the works for our church.

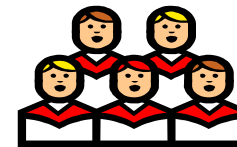

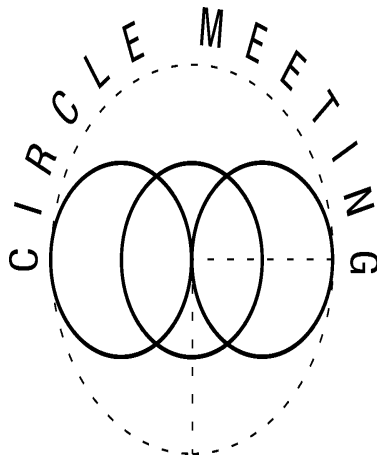
