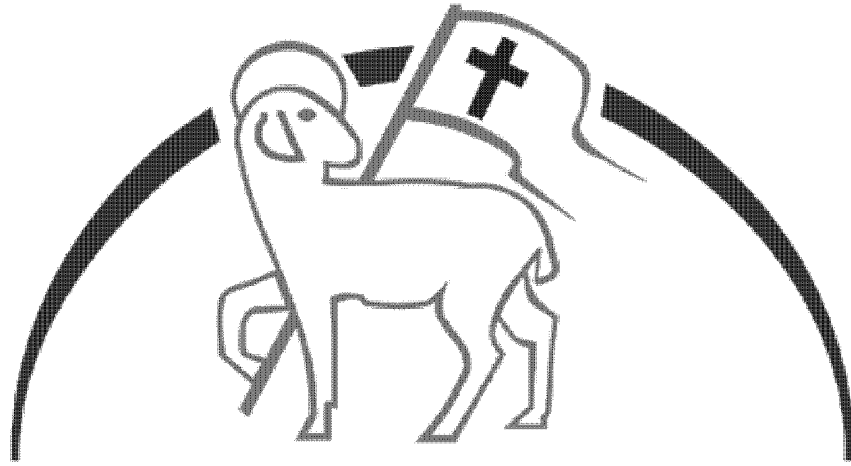


FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
