FOCAL SCRIPTURE PASSAGE

Acts 16:6-10

6 And they went through the region of Phry'gia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. 7 And when they had come opposite My'sia, they attempted to go into Bithy'n'ia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them; 8 so, passing by My'sia, they went down to Tro'as. 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night: a man of Macedo'nia was standing beseeching him and saying, "Come over to Macedo'nia and help us." 10 And when he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go on into Macedo'nia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.
