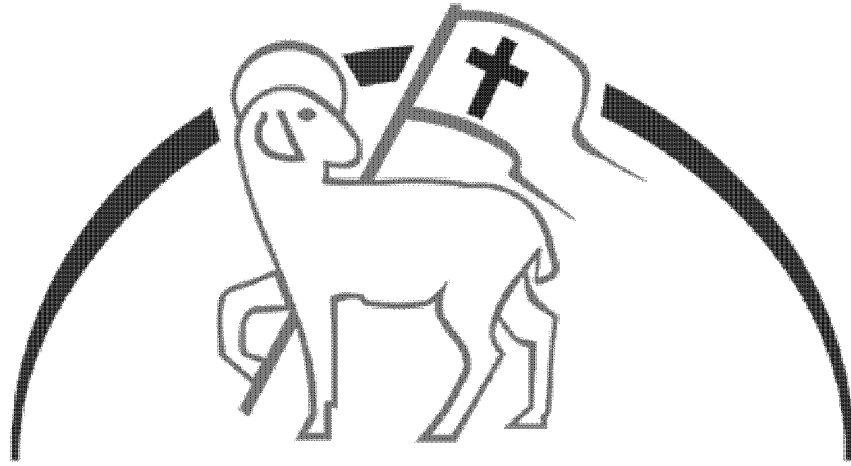


FOURTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

FOCAL SCRIPTURE PASSAGE

Acts 21:30-34

30 Then all the city was aroused, and the people ran together; they seized Paul and dragged him out of the temple, and at once the gates were shut. 31 And as they were trying to kill him, word came to the tribune of the cohort that all Jerusalem was in confusion. 32 He at once took soldiers and centurions, and ran down to them; and when they saw the tribune and the soldiers, they stopped beating Paul. 33 Then the tribune came up and arrested him, and ordered him to be bound with two chains. He inquired who he was and what he had done. 34 Some in the crowd shouted one thing, some another; and as he could not learn the facts because of the uproar, he ordered him to be brought into the barracks.

30 Así que toda la ciudad se conmovió, y se agolpó el pueblo; y apoderándose de Pablo, le arrastraron fuera del templo, e inmediatamente cerraron las puertas. 31 Y procurando ellos matarle, se le avisó al tribuno de la compañía, que toda la ciudad de Jerusalén estaba alborotada. 32 Este, tomando luego soldados y centuriones, corrió a ellos. Y cuando ellos vieron al tribuno y a los soldados, dejaron de golpear a Pablo. 33 Entonces, llegando el tribuno, le prendió y le mandó atar con dos cadenas, y preguntó quién era y qué había hecho. 34 Pero entre la multitud, unos gritaban una cosa, y otros otra; y como no podía entender nada de cierto a causa del alboroto, le mandó llevar a la fortaleza.
