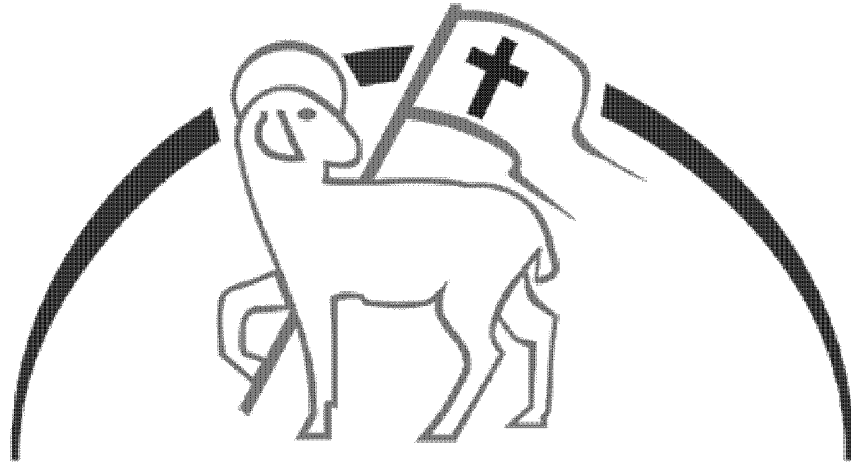


THIRD SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

SCRIPTURE FOCAL PASSAGE

Jonah 3:1-5, 10

1 Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah the second time, saying, 2 "Arise, go to Nin'evah, that great city, and proclaim to it the message that I tell you." 3 So Jonah arose and went to Nin'evah, according to the word of the LORD. Now Nin'evah was an exceedingly great city, three days' journey in breadth. 4 Jonah began to go into the city, going a day's journey. And he cried, "Yet forty days, and Nin'evah shall be overthrown!" 5 And the people of Nin'evah believed God; they proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them to the least of them.

10 When God saw what they did, how they turned from their evil way, God repented of the evil which he had said he would do to them; and he did not do it.

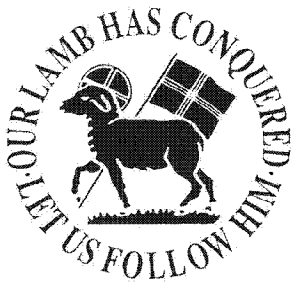
