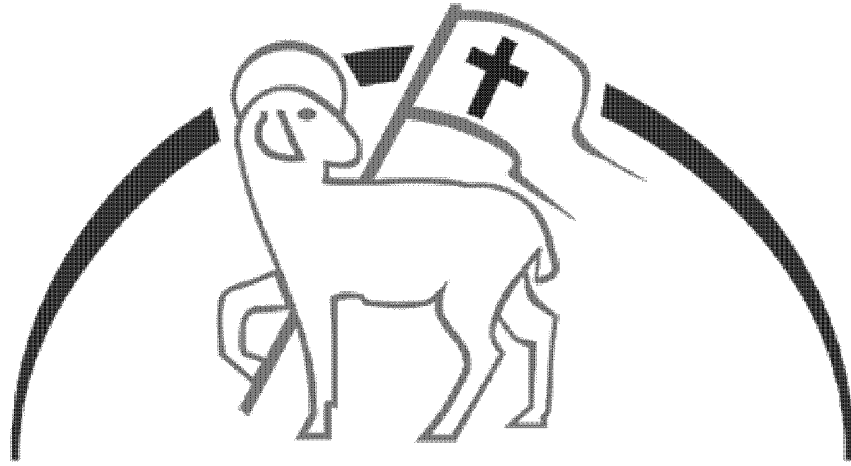


FIFTH SUNDAY IN LENT
