



John Hus

For the beginning of the Moravian Church we look back to John Hus,

though Hus himself was never a member of our church. He was a Roman Catholic priest in Bohemia (part of the modern Czech Republic) in the early 1400s.

Many faithful Christians in the Catholic Church at that time wanted reform in the church to bring it back closer to what they saw as New Testament ideals of simplicity and dedicated service. They placed emphasis on following Scripture and putting faith into practice.

Hus became the advocate for these sentiments in the Czech lands. In addition to his teaching position at the University of Prague, he became the preacher of Bethlehem Chapel in the city. There he stressed the centrality of Scripture, witnessing to one's faith through good works, and reform of both clergy and laity. His sermons drew large crowds daily as he preached to them in their native language. He also encouraged congregational hymn singing, again in Czech, not the liturgical Latin of the church.

Hus's calls for reform angered many in both the church and the state who benefited from the existing system, and they succeeded in getting him exiled from Prague. To clear his name, Hus went to a great council being held in Constance. There, instead of a fair hearing, Hus was condemned and sentenced to be burned at the stake.

His life would be spared if he recanted, but he could not forsake the truth. "Truth will prevail!" was his watchword. His courageous martyrdom on July 6, 1415, inspired many in his homeland to carry on his work, and some of these "Hussites" formed the Moravian Church 42 years later.

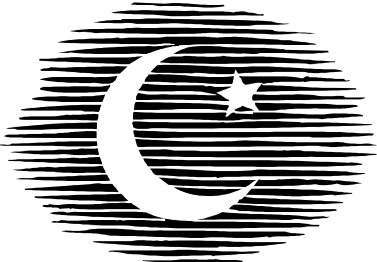

~ SCRIPTURE LESSON ~
Luke 10:1-11

10:1 After this the Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them on ahead of him, two by two, into every town and place where he himself was about to come. 2 And he said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. 3 Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. 4 Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and salute no one on the road. 5 Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace be to this house!' 6 And if a son of peace is there, your peace shall rest upon him; but if not, it shall return to you. 7 And remain in the same house, eating and drinking what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages; do not go from house to house. 8 Whenever you enter a town and they receive you, eat what is set before you; 9 heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' 10 But whenever you enter a town and they do not receive you, go into its streets and say, 11 'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet, we wipe off against you; nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near.'

Pero esto sabed, que el reino de Dios se ha acercado a vosotros.
