1 And as some spoke of the temple, how it was adorned with noble stones and offerings, he said, 6 "As for these things which you see, the days will come when there shall not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down." 7 And they asked him, "Teacher, when will this be, and what will be the sign when this is about to take place?" 8 And he said, "Take heed that you are not led astray; for many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ!' and, 'The time is at hand!' Do not go after them. 9 And when you hear of wars and tumults, do not be terrified; for this must first take place, but the end will not be at once." 10 Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; 11 there will be great earthquakes, and in various places plagues and pestilences; and there will be terrors and great signs from heaven. 12 But before all this they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake. 13 This will be a time for you to bear testimony. 14 Settle it therefore in your minds, not to meditate beforehand how to answer; 15 for I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which none of your adversaries will be able to withstand or contradict. 16 You will be delivered up even by parents and brothers and kinsmen and friends, and some of you they will put to death; 17 but you will be hated by all for my name's sake. 18 But not a hair of your head will perish. 19 By your endurance you will gain your lives.

## PARISH NURSE PROGRAM

We plan to offer the **Parish Nursing Program** in our congregation. This program would provide an extra measure of contact and care for our members. It would be “staffed” by volunteers who are already registered nurses in the church. A training Course for Registered Nurses (required) will be offered this spring. It will be open to those from other congregations who would like to share this training with their churches. The course is scheduled for the last week in April, and is open to all churches in our area. 29 continuing education hours will be given to those attending all classes, and certification granted in the National Parish Nurses Association upon completion of the course. Grants are being applied to cover costs. Ten nurses are needed to secure our instructor, who is traveling here from Wilmington, NC.
