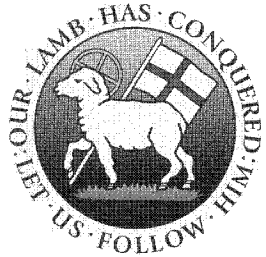

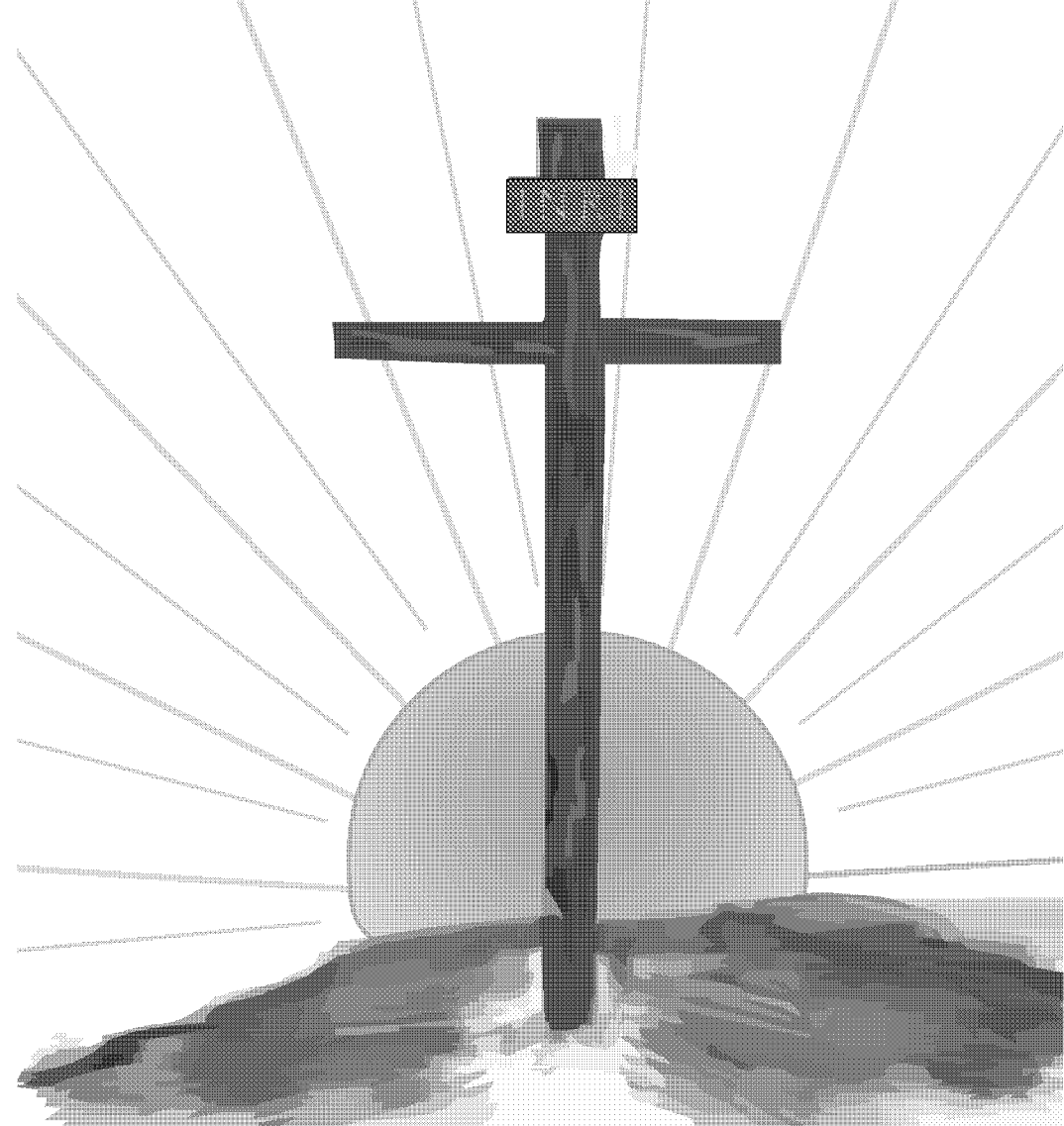

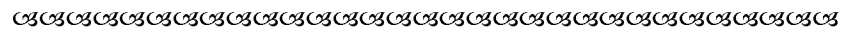
Christ the Lord is ris'n to—day! Al—le-lu-ia!
