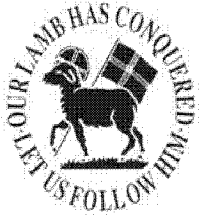

- Bring a poster/visual display that addresses "5 things that have made a difference in your congregation."

Guest speaker, Luther Snow, Lutheran author of *The Power of Asset Mapping: How Your Congregation Can Act on its Gifts*, will facilitate discussions using an interactive process. Our congregation's representatives will work as a congregational "team" as well as with those from other congregations to identify gifts God has given us to use.
