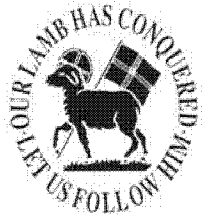

Sunnyside Ministry: 30 Years of Hope

The Sunnyside Ministry of the Southern Province is an emergency assistance agency extending the hand of Christ to individuals and families on the south side of Forsyth County and north central Davidson County. The Board of Evangelism and Home Missions assumed responsibility for this life-changing ministry from Trinity Moravian Church in 1978. The mission remains the same: **to follow Christ by providing hope through service to those in need.**

Sunnyside is people helping people. A small staff and a host of disciples effectively use their gifts to help neighbors overcome threatening situations brought on by limited resources.

Receptionists greet neighbors as they enter Sunnyside. Others serving as **interviewers** speak directly with those seeking help and assess their needs for such things as **rent and energy assistance**. Some people work in the **clothing closet** helping neighbors choose clothing suitable for their needs. Some serve in

the **food pantry** assembling and distributing food packages. Others work in **data entry** to record client files into the computer system. Some are **doctors** who volunteer at a free health clinic. Still others administer a **college scholarship fund**, maintain a **labyrinth garden**, and encourage their congregations to **give generously** to the ministry.
