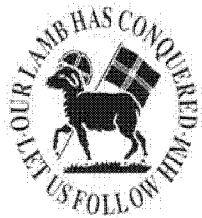

## ~ SCRIPTURE LESSON ~

**11** For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you, **12** that is, that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine. **13** I want you to know, brethren, that I have often intended to come to you (but thus far have been prevented), in order that I may reap some harvest among you as well as among the rest of the Gentiles. **14** I am under obligation both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish: **15** so I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome. **16** For I am not ashamed of the gospel: it is the power of God for salvation to every one who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. **17** For in it the righteousness of God is revealed through faith for faith; as it is written, "He who through faith is righteous shall live."

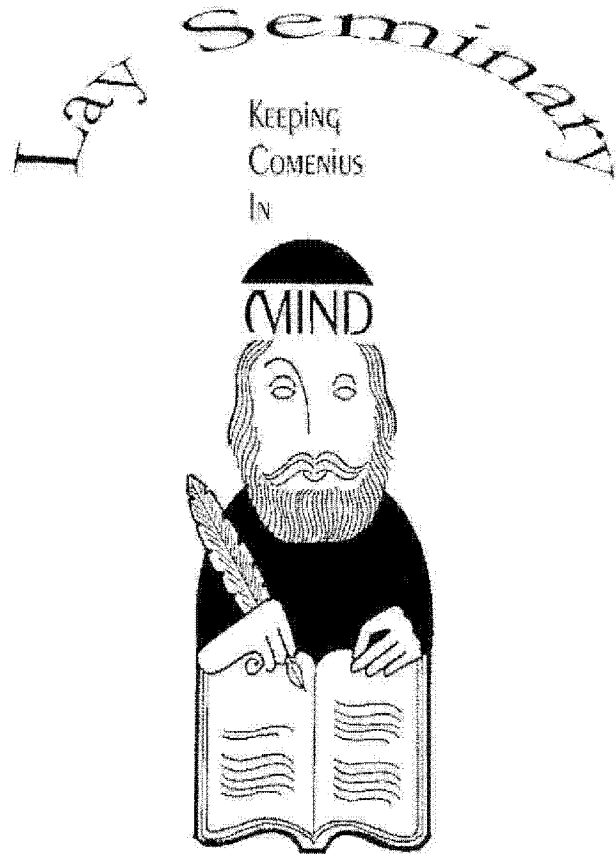
